

# 2 Day Water Restrictions Begin May 1

As of May 1st, lawn watering has been limited to 2 days per week.

Customers may not water their lawn from 10 am – 6 pm.

There is no time limit on watering, but water must not run off landscaping.

- You may hand-water trees, shrubs, vegetable and flower gardens on any day.
- You may wash your car on any day at home with a shut off nozzle and bucket only.
- Commercial car washes are operating under best management practices to reduce water waste.
- Installation of new lawns requires a lawn watering permit, available from Roxborough Water and Sanitation District Offices.
- Planting of Xeric (low water consuming) trees, shrubs and perennials is allowed.
- All pools may open and operate under best management practices (public and private).
